From the outside, the Fort Sumter has a rigid design with optional deck. As you infiltrate the front door, the space opens up to a living room/kitchen open concept. Bar seating for four gives room for a family to sit and watch T.V. while they eat. Full cathedral ceilings with skylights offer plenty of natural light during the day and a glimpse of the starry sky at night! The design also allows a unique sleeping quarters with triple stacked bunk beds, each with its own look-out window. The Fort Sumter features a full size bath with custom shower design. Next to the bath is the master suite, nestled in the second tower. The master suite has quite the luxurious feel with its own built-in whirlpool tub and tall ceilings! 



